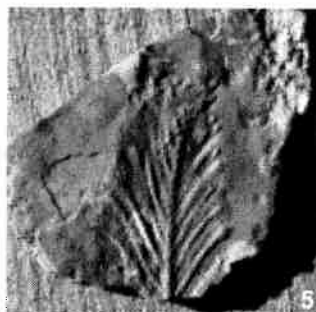
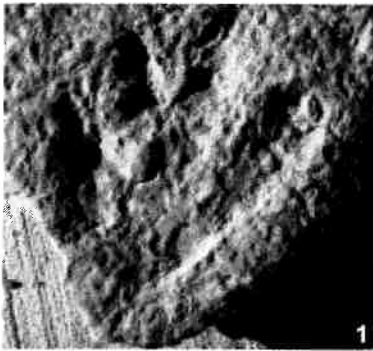


## A Pictorial Essay of Fossil Life in the Grand Staircase - Escalante National Monument Unveiled by UGS Staff



1. *Pseudotetrasauropus*; a possible prosauropod dinosaur track from the Late Triassic Chinle Formation.
2. Cast of log in the Late Cretaceous Drip Tank Member of the Straight Cliffs Formation.
3. *Placenticerus*; an ammonite from the Late Cretaceous Tropic Shale.
4. Theropod dinosaur tracks from the top of the Middle Jurassic Entrada Formation.
5. Araucarian conifer branch from the Late Triassic Chinle Formation.
6. A string of tail vertebrae from a hadrosaurid or duck-billed dinosaur in the Late Cretaceous Kaiparowits Formation.
7. Theropod dinosaur under-tracks from the top of the Middle Jurassic Entrada Formation.
8. Sauropod dinosaur tracks showing a rare tail drag from the top of the Middle Jurassic Entrada Formation.
